Descartes' View on the Mind-Body problem

One of the basic philosophical concepts of reality is mind-matter dualism, which “reduces everything to two different realities” – mind and matter. This is a commonly held view by many, and it separates the mind (or soul) apart from matter (things around us). The Internet Encyclopedia of Philosophy states that “the mind is a thinking thing that lacks the usual attributes of physical objects: size, shape, location, solidity, motion, adherence to the laws of physics, and so on”. This explains the typical belief that mind and matter are separate realities.

Philosopher and mathematician René Descartes was able to break down this concept clearly by making use of his approach to knowledge called the “geometric method”. In this essay, I will discuss Descartes’ philosophy in three stages – the knowledge of mind, the knowledge of God, and the knowledge of matter. By rationalizing the knowledge of mind, Descartes was able to move to rationalizing God’s existence, and used God’s existence to rationalize knowledge of matter.

Since Descartes was a mathematician as well, he appreciated the certainty and rationality of mathematical method. He therefore sought to form a “geometrical method” to ensure “starting points and conclusions might be as certain as those of geometry” – using reason alone to ascertain truths (Miller and Jensen 84).

Descartes began by doubting everything around him, so as to find one unshakeable truth on which to base his philosophy. He made use of the process of systematic doubt, that is, “doubting everything that can be doubted to see if there is anything that
